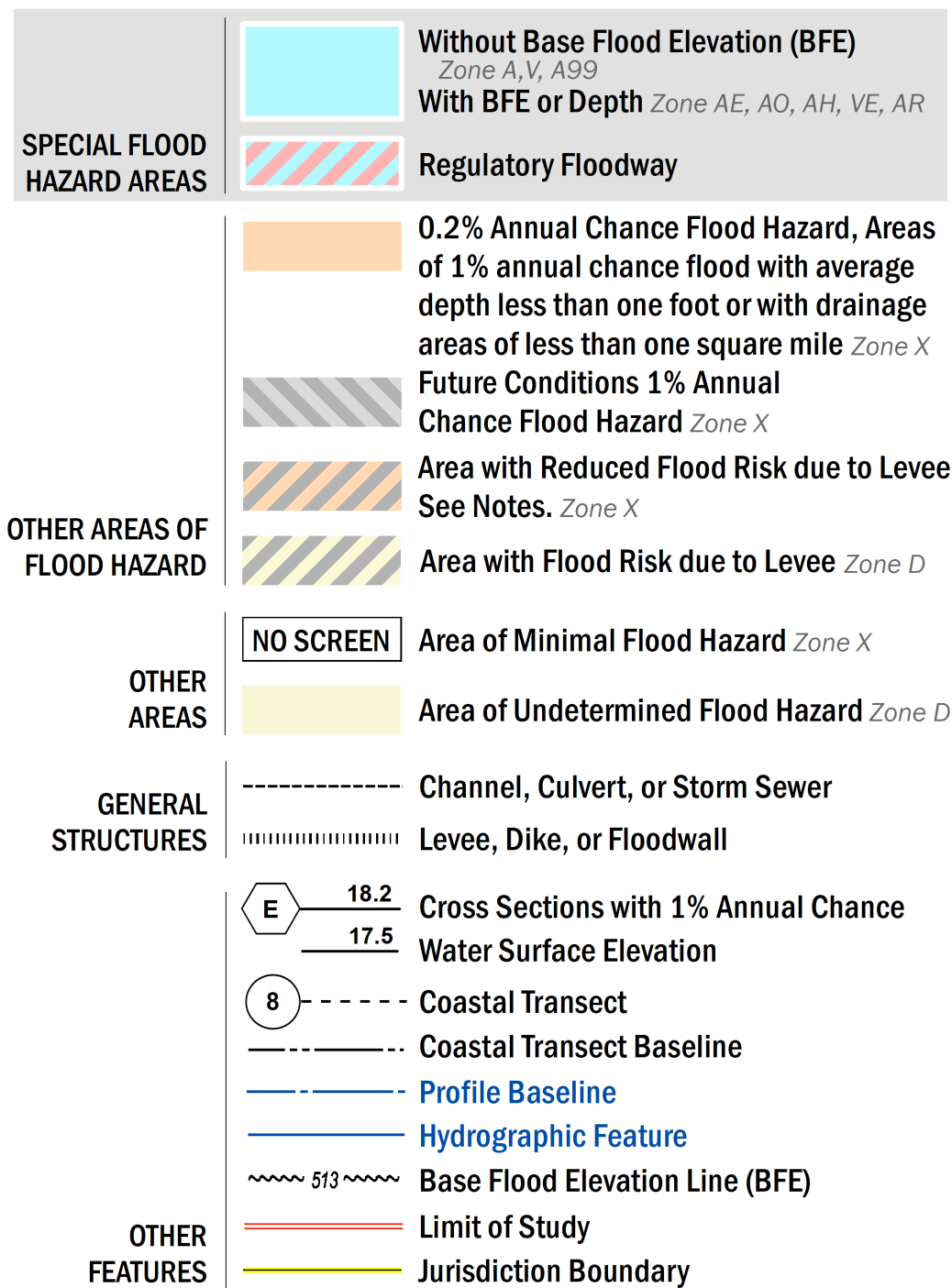

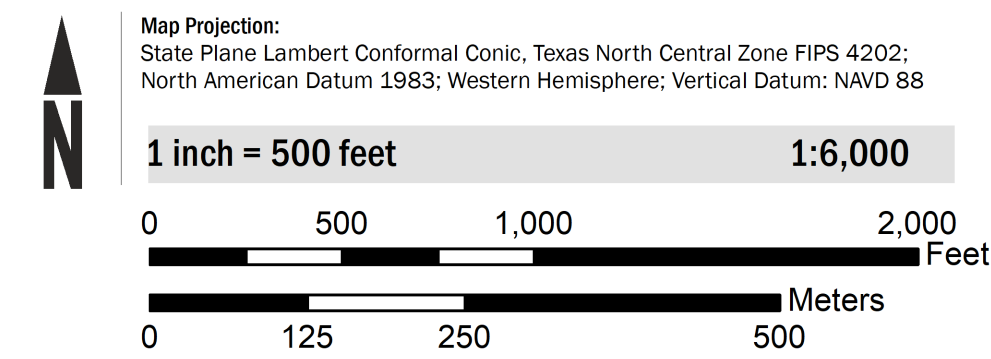
For community and countywide map dates refer to the Flood Insurance Study Report for this jurisdiction.

The Texas Natural Resources Information System (TNRIS) provided the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) county boundaries and transportation layers dated 2015. The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) provided transportation layers and community boundaries dated 2019. Base map data for community boundaries was also provided by local communities dated 2019.
